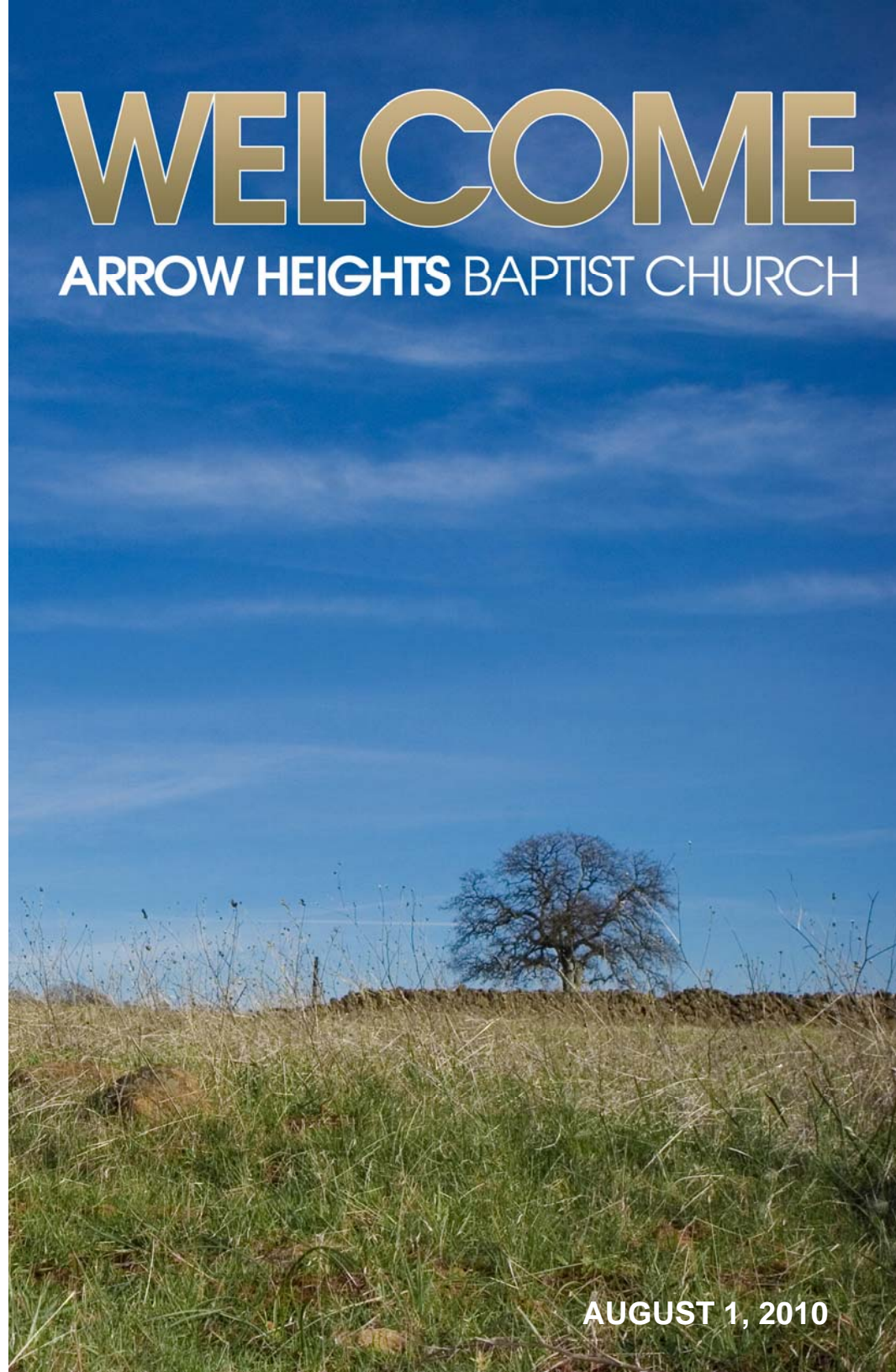

Southern Baptists: A praying people impacting a lost world

AMERICAN PEOPLES. J woke up trembling, his head throbbing. "I can't stand this anymore!" he cried. The headaches had started months ago—so had the nightmares. He had no idea what was causing them. Doctors found nothing wrong. One day a traveling book salesman came to his small town. Desperate to help J, his wife, M, bought a Bible. J began reading it, looking for answers. The more he read, the more intrigued he became. God's Word was new for J, a Santeria priest. Santeria is a mix of African traditional religions and the worship of saints. As he read the Gospel message, J became convinced that it was true. Led by God's Spirit, he and M accepted Christ. J's nightmares and headaches stopped. "You won't believe what happened," he told his Santeria associates. Fascinated by his story, they asked to study the Bible with him. They, too, accepted Christ and formed a Baptist church, with J as pastor. His pulpit covers what once was a Santeria altar. His church members now start churches in the region. Pray that nothing will hinder the spread of the Gospel among the followers of Santeria, one of the unreached people groups in this place of spiritual harvest.

Note: Santeria—An African-based religion similar to voodoo, originating in Cuba and Brazil, which combines the worship of traditional Yoruban deities with the worship of Roman Catholic saints.
